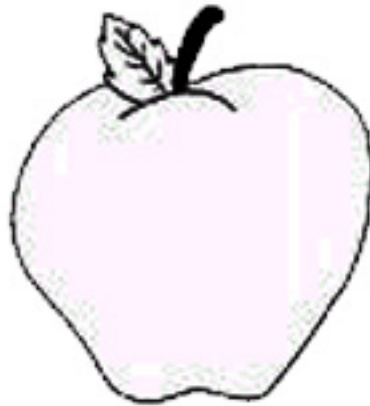
Directions: Below is a made up recipe for stuffed apple rings.

## Stuffed Apple Rings

### Cooking Utensils

1. apple corer
2. knife
3. measuring spoons
4. spoon
5. cutting board



### Ingredients

1. 1 apple
2. 2 tablespoons peanut butter
3. 1 teaspoon sunflower seeds
4. 1 teaspoon honey

### What to Do

1. Gently wash and dry the apple
2. Slowly combine peanut butter, sunflower seeds, and honey. Stir quickly until well mixed
3. With the corer, rapidly remove the core and seeds from the center of the apple.
4. Using a spoon, carefully stuff the apple with the peanut butter mixture.
5. On the cutting board, softly lay the apple on its side and cautiously cut it into 4 or 5 slices.
6. Joyfully eat what you made
