causing or likely to injure or hurt someone or something.

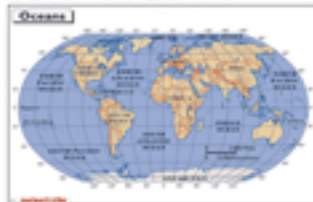


help: noun, verb
